

1st Annual Turkey Throwdown Hog Show

November 17, 2018

Show Rules:

Entries may be Barrows or Gilts and must have an ear tag that matches the entry form. No limit to the number of animals you can show.

Each exhibitor of hogs must assume all liability in case of death or injury to his/her hogs.

To exhibit animals in this show, the animals must have a negative brucellosis and negative pseudorabies test within 30 days of show. You must also have a certificate of veterinary inspection.

All hogs will be weighed individually upon arrival, inspected by the committee and assigned to a class. There will be no re-weighs. (times for weighing will be Friday from 5-8 p.m. and Saturday from 6-9 a.m.)

Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal in showmanship. (All exhibitors will be entered in showmanship) (A belt buckle will be awarded to each division winner) Showmanship will begin at 11:00am

- Primary: Class 1: Grades- Pre school-3rd
- Junior: Class 2: Grades- 4th-8th
- Senior: Class 3: Grades- 9th-12th

Classes will begin 30 minutes after showmanship. Classes will be split, based on weight. Prize money will be paid through three places in each class.

Barrows and Gilts will show together. Top 5 overall will be selected from the previous class winners. Prize money includes: Grand- \$500, Reserve- \$400, Third- \$250 Fourth- \$150 Fifth- \$100. Based on 100 head show. Prize money will increase if there are more than 100 entries.

Pigs will be single penned.

This is a non-terminal show, and hogs may be loaded out during the show after exhibitors have finished showing. Show administration reserves the right to stop this process if it begins to interfere with the flow of animals to the show arena. All swine must be removed immediately after the show.

Entries should be postmarked by November 3, 2018. If postmarked after November 3, 2018 a late entry fee of an additional \$30 per head will apply. Late entry fees are \$30 per pig and will be enforced. Make checks Payable to Lee County Livestock Association.
