2019 ATCO Heifer Showdown Livestock Show Rules

January 26th

1. **Eligibility:** Open to all bonafide FFA, 4-H, and Preclub members (age 9 to 12th grade)
2. **This is a BLOW AND GO SHOW—Limited Tie Outs--Shown off Trailer**
3. **No more than two steers and three heifers can be entered per exhibitor.**
4. **Steers and heifers must be owned, in the possession of and under the daily care of the exhibitor by October 1, 2018.**
5. **An original registration certificate is required on all registered heifers.**
6. **Current health papers are required.**
7. **Heifer information:**
All Heifers must be born January 1, 2017 and after. It is recommended that steers are born August 1, 2017 and after. Classes will be broken out according to entries received.
8. **Registered heifers will be shown by birthdate.**
9. **Commercial heifers will be shown by weight.**
10. **There must be at least 5 heifers of one breed to constitute a breed class. All others will be placed in other breeds class.**
11. **Breeding Heifers will be broken in the following classes, A Breed/Division with 7 or less entries will be shown with no age break.**

Early Heifer Calf Class – 5/31/2018 to 1/1/2018

Heifer Calf Class – 12/31/2017 to 9/1/2017

Intermediate Heifer Class – 8/31/2017 to 5/1/2017

Junior Yearling Heifer Class – 4/30/2017 to 1/1/2017

There will be a Grand and Reserve Champion from each breed and those two heifers will then compete for an Overall Top 5 in a final drive.

1st and 2nd place in each class, Grand and Reserve in each breed and the final Top 5 will receive premiums

12. **Steer information:**
Steers will be shown by weight. There will be no breed classes.

****Prize money will be based on participation and sponsorship**

13. **The Atkinson County Livestock Committee reserves the right to interpret all rules. Decisions of the judge(s), classifiers, and the rules committee will be final.**
14. **Exhibitors are responsible for his or her own animal and assume all risk associated.**
