## UGA Classic City Showdown Steer and Heifer Show

~NEW SHOW FORMAT – ONE DAY~

We cordially invite you to the UGA Classic City Showdown Steer and Heifer Show. This will be a **one-day show** at the UGA Instructional Arena in Athens, GA on Saturday, January 12, 2019. The barn will be open on Friday, January 11<sup>th</sup> from 5-9pm for early arrivals. Check-in will be Saturday morning from 7-9am and the show will start at 10:00am with showmanship (youngest to oldest). The UGA Instructional Arena address is 2600 S Milledge Ave, Athens, Ga. Concessions will be available for breakfast and lunch on Saturday.

### Rules & Regulations:

1. The barn will be open for early arrivals on Friday evening from 5-9pm. Check-in will be Saturday morning from 7-9am.
2. Show will start promptly at 10:00am with 4<sup>th</sup> grade showmanship, followed by the registered heifer show and then the market heifer and steer show.
3. Eligibility: Open to all FFA and 4-H members, 4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade, from Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, Tennessee, Alabama, and Florida. We will limit entries to the first 150 head, if necessary.
4. Entries must be postmarked by December 21, 2018. Entry fees will be \$25/head. Entry fees are non-refundable. Make checks payable to UGA Block & Bridle Club. Mail entry forms to UGA Block & Bridle Club, University of Georgia, Animal and Dairy Science Department, 425 River Rd, Athens, GA 30602
5. There will be no limit to number of head you can enter. Duplicate entry form as needed.
6. An official health certificate must accompany each animal. A Ga Dept of Ag Inspector will be on the premises Saturday during check-in.
7. Stall space will be first come, first serve. A base layer of shavings will be provided the same as previous years. You can bring shavings, but straw will not be allowed.
8. Blocking chutes will be allowed in the back half of the covered arena and on the outside end of each aisle.
9. Fitting is allowed, but optional. No aerosol cans in the make-up areas.
10. Showmanship will be divided into three divisions – Junior, Intermediate, & Senior. The Junior division will consist of 4<sup>th</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The Intermediate division will consist of 7<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> grade. The Senior division will consist of 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. *Belt buckles will be awarded for each division winner.*
11. All registered heifers must have a registration certificate.
12. Registered heifers must be in exhibitors name by Nov 1, 2018.
13. Registered heifers will show by breed and then birthdate. Heifers can be born from January 2017 through May 2018. Breeds with less than 5 head will be put into All Other Breeds. *Exception: If less than 5 head of Low % Simmental or High % Simmental, then they will be combined for a % Simmental Show.* A Grand and Reserve Champion will be selected from each breed.
14. Commercial heifers will show by weight. There will be a Grand and Reserve Champion selected.
15. Grand and Reserve Champions from each breed will come back for an Overall Grand and Reserve Champion Heifer selection.
16. Exhibitors can show in **both** the commercial show and market heifer show. Enter heifer in each show on entry form. Entry fee required for both.
17. Market heifers and steers will show by weight. Heifers and steers will show in separate classes. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place from each class will come back for a Grand and Reserve Champion Market selection.
18. If an exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, another exhibitor can show the animal.
19. Premiums will be based on sponsorships.
