Show Schedule:

Check in - 7:00 am – 9:30 am (barn will open at 6:30am)

Show will start at 10:30 am with showmanship

(Pre-club, Novice, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior)

Classes will follow showmanship.

The Stephens County FFA Alumni chapter will have a concession stand with items available for breakfast, lunch, and snacks.

General Rules

1. All animals must be checked in and weighed prior to 9:30 am Saturday, February 2, 2019.
2. There will be no re-weighs after the hogs leave the scale area. All exhibitors questioning weights should voice concern at the time the animal's weight is announced.
3. Any exhibitor who is a high school senior or younger is eligible to show. All exhibitors must be able to exhibit his/her animal without the assistance of an adult or older exhibitor in the ring.
4. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal unless the exhibitor has more than one in the same class.
5. All animal projects will be shown at the owner's own risk. Each exhibitor must assume responsibility in the case of death or injury.
6. Hogs will be penned 2 per pen. Bring a divider if you need one. Pens will be available on a first come first serve basis. Bedding will be provided for each pen. Be prepared to show off your trailer if needed.
7. Because of limited space, tack pens are not available.
8. All animals must have current health papers at time of unloading. All animals must be PRV and Brucellosis negative and have an official health certificate.
9. No clipping of hogs at the show.
10. There will be a **limit of 4 hogs** per exhibitor. First **150** hogs accepted.
11. All animals must have a clean, readable ear tag.
12. Showmanship classes: Pre- Club (2nd grade & under), Novice (3rd – 5th grades), Junior (6th – 8th grades), Intermediate (9th – 10th grades), and Senior (11th – 12th grades)
13. Classes will be split based on weight.
14. Barrows and gilts will be shown separate.
15. Payouts will be determined after all entries have been received.
16. The judge's decision is final in all classes.
17. Show officials reserve the right to make changes deemed to be in the best interest of the show.
18. No tobacco products or smokeless tobacco products allowed in the barn and show ring areas.

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
