Entry Fee: \$25/head ~ before January 25, 2018

Any entries postmarked after this date will incur a \$5/head late fee.

We will accept entries the day of the show with a \$10/head late fee.

General Rules:

- Health Papers will be checked.
 - All Georgia State Steer and Heifer rules apply.
 - This is a blow and go show.
 - If you have to wash it out you are not allowed to use it; this includes any adhesives and paint.
 - Any heifer registered breeds with less than 5 head will show as AOB.
 - Commercial heifers will show by weight.
 - Heifers will show for Top 5.
 - All steers will show by weight (Grand and Reserve only).
 - We will have a Cow/Calf class that will encompass all breeds of pairs entered.

Awards:

- Showmanship will be broken down into individual grades, and buckles will be awarded to the first place showman of each grade.
- Top 5 Heifers will receive respectively \$250, \$200, \$150, \$100, \$75.
- Grand and Reserve steers will receive \$250, and \$200.
- Each breed or weight class will also receive payouts.
