## GENERAL RULES

1. All persons making entries should acquaint themselves with the rules and regulations found at [www.exchangeclubfair.org](http://www.exchangeclubfair.org)
2. Entries are only open to Georgia 4-H and FFA members and forms are available at [www.exchangeclubfair.org](http://www.exchangeclubfair.org).
3. Each exhibitor or his/her parent or guardian and agent/advisor shall sign the entry form stating the exhibitor has owned and cared for their livestock at least 60 days prior to the fair with the exception of prospect swine.
4. Entry forms which require the age of the animal will be used by the show committee and are found at [www.exchangeclubfair.org](http://www.exchangeclubfair.org) and must be submitted prior to October 12, 2021.
5. All pure breeds must have registration papers in the name of the exhibitor with ownership date prior to September 1<sup>st</sup>.
6. The show committee will determine classes as soon as possible after weigh in closes. There will be NO re-weighs. The committee's decision is final.
7. Livestock determined by the show committee to be UNFIT for showing or UNMANAGABLE will not be allowed to show.
8. No clipping or shaving allowed inside the barn unless the show committee determines inclement weather conditions.

9. All animals will be bedded with wood shavings provided once by the fair association. Exhibitor may provide extra shavings if they desire more bedding for their animals.

10. Competent caretakers will care for their animals at all times, providing feed and water, day and night. The fair association will not be responsible for losses beyond exercising diligent care.

11. All shows will begin promptly at specified times.

12. All exhibitors must be present and in the ring at the time of judging, unless otherwise granted by the show committee.

13. All exhibitors must show his/her own animal in showmanship.

14. In the event a weight class has less than five (5) entries, the show committee will determine/adjust the distribution and amount of premiums. No Exceptions.

15. All animals will be released at the end of each show, but will not be loaded during an on-going show unless otherwise specified by species show rules.

16. Refer to specific animal sections for additional rules and information.

17. An exhibitor and their animals may be disqualified for the following:

- a. Criticizing or interfering with the judge, exhibitors, show committee, weigh-in personnel, grievance committee, and other show officials or any conduct detrimental to the show.
- b. Failure to properly care for animals while at the show grounds to include feeding/water, bedding, and handling deemed appropriate by the show committee and veterinarian if needed.
- c. Failure to properly enter all species on dates assigned by the Southwest Georgia Regional Fair Livestock Show in accordance with the official rules and regulations specified.

## **Livestock Rules**

**Entries are open to the State of Georgia.**

**\*\*Exhibitors MUST feed and water your own animal at all times while they are on the fairgrounds\*\***

**\*All Animals will be bedded with wood shavings bring extra if you want more than what will be supplied by the Fairgrounds**

### **SWINE**

- Entries will be received on fairgrounds 8am to 12pm on Wednesday.
- Show will start at 3pm. on Wednesday.
- Each exhibitor can show a total of 4 head of swine in the Market and Breeding Gilt show but no more than 2 market hogs and an additional 2 prospect pigs.
- Entries are open only to Georgia 4-H, FFA, and pre-club. (Pre club students must be able to show their animals without any assistance)

### **PUREBRED GILTS**

- A. All registered breeds of swine are eligible for the following classes and premiums provided there are seven or more entries per breed; otherwise, the breeds will be shown together in Other Breeds class.
- B. Gilts farrowed in February, March, and April of 2021 are eligible for the show.
- C. All registered gilts must be registered in the exhibitor's name before September 1, 2021.

### **COMMERCIAL GILTS**

- A. All gilts will be weighed and classed by weight upon arrival. Commercial gilts must weigh 220 lbs – 350 lbs.
- B. All commercial gilts must have an ear tag that matches the entry form.

### **MARKET SWINE**

- A. Entries may be barrows or gilts and must have an ear tag that matches the entry form.
- B. Entries that are lighter than 200 lbs. and heavier than 290 lbs., castrated late, or not of show caliber will be eliminated by the screening committee.
- C. No more than two market swine can be entered by an exhibitor in the show.
- D. All hogs will be weighed individually upon arrival, inspected by screening committee and assigned to a class. There will be no re-weighs.
- E. All market hogs will be shown in equal classes divided by weight.
- F. This is a **non-Terminal** show, and hogs may be loaded out during the show after exhibitors have finished showing. Show administration reserves the right to stop this process if it begins to interfere with the flow of animals to the show arena.

## Prospect Show Pig Show

- Exhibitors can show 2 prospect pigs in addition to the Breeding Gilts and Market Swine.
- Pigs must weigh 199 pounds and down.
- Barrows and Gilts will show together.
- Classes will be split according to numbers.
- Prospect pigs can show in regular Swine Showmanship.
- There will be a Grand Champion and Reserve Champion prospect.
- Premiums will be the same as other Swine Classes.

## MARKET GOATS

- A. The goat show will start at 3 p.m. on Thursday.
- B. Market Goat classes are open only to Georgia 4-H, FFA, and pre-club. (pre club students must be able to show their animals without any assistance)
- C. Goats must enter on a certificate of veterinary inspection issued along Georgia guidelines for youth exhibits. All goats must be identified with USDA approved individual animal identification to the flock of origin (scrapie tag). This information must be recorded on the certificate of veterinary inspection on all goats including wethers: "To the best of my knowledge, the animals being exhibited are free from any clinical signs consistent with those of foot rot, scabies, contagious ecthyma (sore mouth), cutaneous fungal lesions, scrapie or any other infectious or contagious disease."
- D. This show is open to any breed or crossbred doe or wether.
- E. Goats will be weighed by show officials from 8am to 12 pm on Thursday of show week. Goats will be classed and shown by weight according to show officials at their discretion.
- F. Each exhibitor may enter four market goats.
- G. All goats must be carrying their milk teeth.
- H. All goats must have an ear tag.

## LAMBS

- A. Lambs will be weighed in from 8am to 12 pm on Friday. Show will start at 3 p.m. on Friday.
- B. Must be free of foot rot, scabies, sour mouth, and fungus.
- C. Entries are open only to Georgia 4-H, FFA, and pre-club. (pre club students must be able to show their animals without any assistance)
- D. Sheep must enter on a certificate of veterinary inspection issued along Georgia guidelines for youth exhibits. All Sheep, except must be identified with USDA approved individual animal identification to the flock of origin (scrapie tag). This information must be recorded on the certificate of veterinary inspection on all Sheep including wethers: “To the best of my knowledge, the animals being exhibited are free from any clinical signs consistent with those of foot rot, scabies, contagious ecthyma (sore mouth), cutaneous fungal lesions, scrapie or any other infectious or contagious disease.”
- E. A maximum of three lambs per exhibitor will be allowed.
- F. Entries must be wethers or ewe lambs. (No ram lambs will be allowed.)
- G. All lambs must be trained for showing.
- H. All entries must have their tails docked.
- I. All lambs must weigh a minimum of 75 pounds.
  
- J. Lambs will be shown in short fleece. (1/2” or less)
- K. Lambs will be SHOWN BY WEIGHT and Hair breeds will be a separate class if 5 or more are in the show. Wool and Hair Breeds will show together for Grand and Reserve Champions. Lambs will be weighed upon arrival and there will be no re-weighs.
- L. Exhibitors must show their own animal in showmanship classes.
- M. Please bring your own feed trough.
- N. All lambs entered in the show will be shown by equal classes divided by weight.
- O. A pre-club lamb showmanship class will be held at the beginning of the lamb show. No registration required. Exhibitors must be younger than 1<sup>st</sup> grade.

## CATTLE

- Cattle must be received on fairgrounds by 1pm. Friday. Cattle weigh in will be from 8am to 1 pm on Friday.
- Entries are open only to Georgia 4-H and FFA members in grades 4-12. Exhibitors must be 9 years old by September 1, 2021.
- Each exhibitor can show up to six heifers and four steers.
- **Stall assignments will be made at check in. See show official for assignments.**

### **REGISTERED HEIFERS**

- A. Must be registered in exhibitor name by September 1, 2021.
- B. Registered heifers will be split by British and Continental breeds if there are 5 of each group, and then classed by age at the show committee discretion. Heifers must be Born after January 1, 2020

### **COMMERCIAL HEIFERS**

- A. Heifers will be shown by weight. Show officials will weigh commercial heifers and there will be no re-weighs. All commercial heifers must be born January 1, 2020 and after.
- B. All commercial heifers must have an ear tag.

- D. Each county or school may enter two senior teams (9<sup>th</sup> grade and above) with four members per team and two junior teams (9<sup>th</sup> grade and below) with four members per team.
- E. The top 3 team member scores will be used in computing the team score.
- F. Breeding and market Cattle, Swine, Sheep and Goats will be judged according to animal availability.
- G. 4-H and FFA members will compete together.
- H. Buses will need to enter the Livestock Gate and then turn Left through the gate to park in the parking lot.
