1. Any exhibitor that has not completed 12th grade and is a member of 4-H or FFA is eligible to show.
2. All market goats must have an official up to date health certificate and signatures.
3. Market wether goats and does will be shown together and ewes and wether lambs will be shown together.
4. Each market goat or lamb entered must have a clean, readable scrapie ear tag in place. The tag must be in the animal before check in. All entries must include an ear tag number for all market goats/lambs on the entry form.
5. All entries must be postmarked and received through **EMAIL AND MAIL** by September 7^h, 2021

6. There will be no re-weighs after the goats/lambs leave the scale area.

7. The barn will be open on Wednesday, September 22nd, for those wishing to unload at the fairgrounds during the day; the grounds will be opened at 2:30 pm. Check in will be from 3:30pm – 5:00 pm, Wednesday, September 22nd. Please arrive during these times with health papers ready.

8. Goat Showmanship will begin at 6:00 pm on Wednesday, September 22

Class break-downs will depend on the number of entries. Showmanship will start with the youngest exhibitors and continue by age until the final class. The goat market classes will begin following showmanship and followed by the lamb show.

1. Penning will be a minimum of two animals per a pen unless there is a single entry.

Animals must pen in the barn. Once pens are full, all other entries will be returned.
