- Show is Saturday November 13, 2021.
 - Check in 7am –9am
 - Show starts at 10:00 a.m.
 - Show Order:
 - Showmanship (shown by grade--youngest to oldest)
 - Steers (shown by weight)
 - Heifers- British (shown by birthdate), Continental (shown by birthdate), Commercial (shown by weight)
 - No market heifers
 - *Show management reserves the right to adjust the number of classes based on entries.*
- Steers and commercial heifers will be shown by weight.
 - Steers will show for Grand and Reserve.
- Registered heifers will be shown by age (Born After 1/1/2020)
 - Registered and commercial heifers will show for Grand and Reserve.
- This is a “blow and go” show. No fitting is allowed
- Exhibitors may have to tie to trailers if there are no spaces left in the barn
- Bring generators due to electrical shortage capacity
- An official health certificate is required by Georgia Department of Agriculture regulations must accompany steers and heifers. Health papers may be subject to be checked upon arrival.
- Premium money paid out according to availability of funds.
- Entry forms should be postmarked November 5, 2021.
- Additional \$10/head fee will be added if received after the date up to show date.
- Make entries payable to Floyd County Young Farmers.
- Exhibitors and guests will be expected to follow social distancing guidelines. Please do not attend the show if you are exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms or have recently tested positive.
- Pre-packaged snack concessions will be available. There are a variety of fast-food restaurants close to the Fairgrounds for complete meal options.
