Despite Covid-19, you are invited to the **12th Annual Snow Flurries Classic Dairy Heifer Show** on Saturday, January 23rd in Cleveland, Georgia. This show will be open to all FFA or 4-H members in Georgia.

The entry fee is \$20.00 per heifer with a limit of 3 heifers for each exhibitor. Classes will be divided into heats depending on the number of entries per class or division. Remember, all state show rules will be in effect and health papers will be required. Due to social distancing standards placed into effect by our country, the show will be limited to 100 head of cattle this year. Entries that exceed the limit will be contacted and entry fees returned.

Each exhibitor will receive one t-shirt with their entry fee. Additional shirts can be purchased for \$12 each. Include additional shirt orders on the entry form. T-shirts will not be available for late entries.

The White County FFA will be running the concession stand during the event and offer lunch and snack items throughout the day.
