“Bulldog Showdown” Heifer & Steer Show
Saturday, January 29, 2022



We cordially invite you to the “Bulldog Showdown” Heifer & Steer Show. This will be held at the Hart County AgriScience Center in Hartwell, Ga on Saturday, January 29, 2022. The barn will be open on Friday, January 28th from 5-8pm for early arrivals. Check-in will be Saturday morning from 7-9am and the show will start at 9:30am with showmanship (youngest to oldest). The Hart County AgriScience Center address is 1951 Bowman Hwy, Hartwell, Ga. Concessions will be available for breakfast and lunch on Saturday.

Rules & Regulations:

1. The barn will be open for early arrivals on Friday evening from 5-8pm. Check-in will be Saturday morning from 7-9am.
2. Show will start promptly at 9:30am with 4th grade, followed by the heifer show and then the steer show.
3. Entries must be postmarked by January 14, 2022. Entry fees will be \$25/head. Entry fees are non-refundable. Make checks payable to Hart County FFA Alumni. Mail entry forms to Hart County FFA Alumni, Attn: Cow Show, 5080 Bowersville Hwy, Bowersville, GA 30516
4. Eligibility: Open to all FFA and 4-H members, 4th to 12th grade, from Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, Tennessee, Alabama, and Florida. We will limit entries to the first 150 head.
5. There will be no limit to number of head each exhibitor can enter.
6. An official health certificate must accompany each animal. A Ga Dept of Ag Inspector will be on the premises Saturday during check-in.
7. Stall assignments will be pre-assigned by county. If you have requests to be near another county, please specify on entry form. Shavings will be provided.
8. Blocking Chutes will be allowed on the outer walls of either side of the barn. Do not put them in a tie space.
9. This is a blow and go show. No fitting.
10. Showmanship will be by grade, starting with 4th grade and going through 12th grade. If heats are needed, we may split a grade into heats. All exhibitors must show their own animal.
11. All registered heifers must have a registration certificate.
12. Registered heifers must be in exhibitors name by Nov 1, 2021.
13. Registered heifers will show by breed and then birthdate. Breeds with less than 4 head will be put into All Other Breeds. Exception: If less than 4 head of Low % Simmentals, then they will be combined with High % Simmentals for a % Simmental Show. A Grand and Reserve Champion will be selected from each breed.
14. Commercial heifers will show by weight. There will be a Grand and Reserve Champion selected.
15. Grand and Reserve Champions from each breed plus, Commercial will come back for an Overall Grand and Reserve Champion Heifer selection.
16. Steers will show by weight. There will be a Grand and Reserve Champion selected.
17. If an exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, another exhibitor can show the animal.
18. Premiums will be based on sponsorships.
