Showmanship:

Classes will be formed based on number of entries in each age group.

Registered Heifers:

All registered heifers will show together and divided into classes by weight based on entries.

All commercial heifers and steers will be shown by weight and divided into classes based on participation and number of entries.

2023 ATCO Heifer Showdown Livestock Show Rules
Atkinson County Cattle Barn **Pearson GA** **January 7, 2023**

1. Eligibility: Open to all bonafide FFA, 4-H, and Preclub members
2. This is a BLOW AND GO SHOW—Limited Tie Outs--Shown off Trailer
3. No more than two steers and three heifers can be entered per exhibitor.
4. Steers and heifers must be owned, in the possession of and under the daily care of the exhibitor by October 1, 2022.
5. An original registration certificate is required on all registered heifers.
6. Current health papers are required.
7. Heifer information:
All Heifers must be born January 1, 2020 and after. Classes will be broken out according to entries received.
8. Registered heifers will be shown by birthdate.
9. Commercial heifers will be shown by weight.
10. Breeding Heifers will be broken in the following classes. All breeds will show together.

Early Heifer Calf Class – 5/31/2022 to 1/1/2022

Heifer Calf Class – 12/31/2021 to 9/1/2021

Intermediate Heifer Class – 8/31/2021 to 5/1/2021

Junior Yearling Heifer Class – 4/30/2021 to 1/1/2021

There will be a Grand and Reserve Champion from each breed and those two heifers will then compete for an Overall Top 5 in a final drive. 1st and 2nd place in each class and the final Top 5 heifers will receive premiums.

**Prize money will be based on participation and sponsorship

11. Steer information:
Steers will be shown by weight. There will be no breed classes. 1st and 2nd place in each class and Grand and Reserve Steer will receive premiums.
12. The Atkinson County Livestock Committee reserves the right to interpret all rules. Decisions of the judge(s), classifiers, and the rules committee will be final.
13. Exhibitors are responsible for his or her own animal and assume all risk associated.
