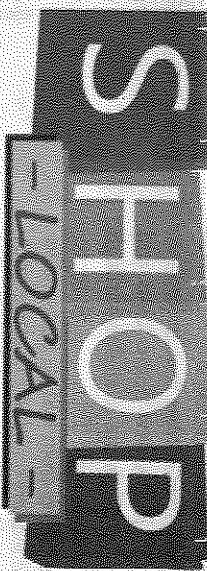
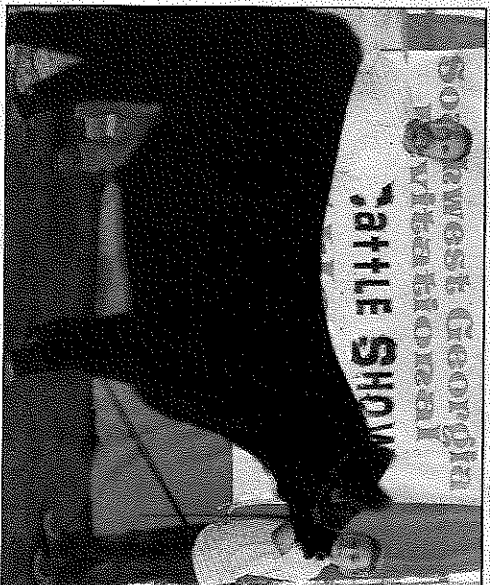

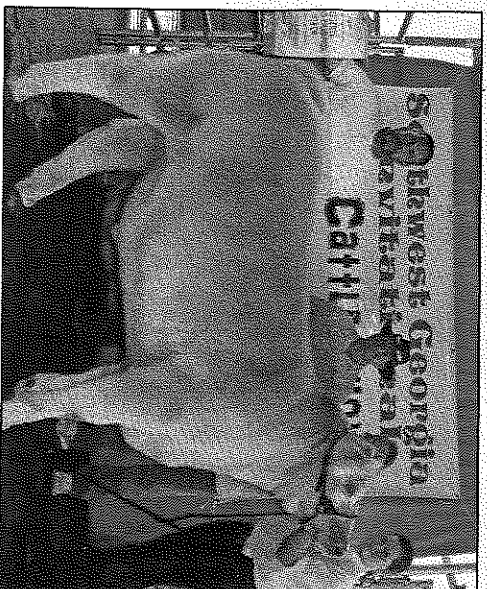
Grand Champion Steer

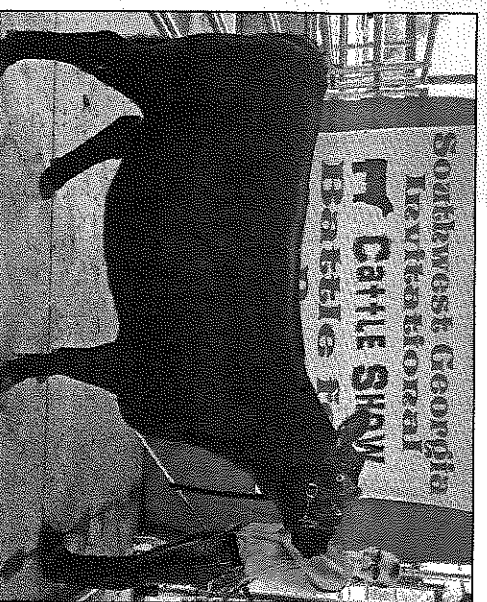

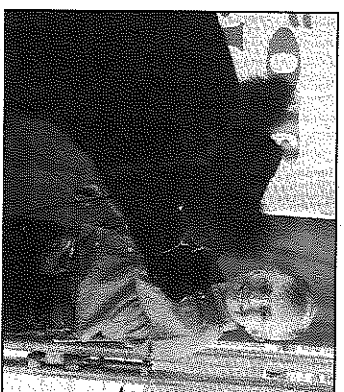

The Southwest Georgia Invitational Cattle Show was held this past Saturday with another great turnout at the Seminole County Agricultural Center show barn. The event is one of the only existing invitational cattle shows in Southwest Georgia. Just last year, the show experienced a huge boost in participation, which resulted in a show record of fifty-seven youngsters who exhibited fifty-seven heifers and twenty-four steers for a total of eighty-one animals.

This year's show fell short of last year's record, but still featured impressive numbers as forty 4-H and FFA members exhibited forty-seven heifers and twenty-two steers for a total of sixty-nine animals.

The weigh-in for all steers and heifers was held from 8:00-9:00 a.m., and the show began at 10 a.m. with Senior Showmanship followed by Junior and Elementary Showmanship. The heifer show was held next with a total of nine classes followed by five classes of steers.

The first place winner in each of the three showmanship classes received a belt buckle and a large-sized laser-cut metal cow. The Senior Showmanship Champion was LeAnn Beville. Senior Show-

manship Reserve Champion was Trace Lamberth. The Junior Showmanship Champion was Maelee Dean. Jr. Showmanship Reserve Champion was Lauryn Edwards. The Elementary Showmanship Champion was Fallon Ray. Elementary Showmanship Reserve Champion was Maddox Miller.
