The ag center road (Station Ridge) is on the West side of the Fannin Co Fire Station/911 Center (so turn left at the stop sign on Windy Ridge, then right on Station Ridge & follow the road down to the ag center).

1. This show is open to 4-H and FFA members through 12th grade in school plus pre-club age children in grades 1-4 as of September 1, 2023.
2. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor on or before November 16, 2023.
3. [An entry form](#) signed by the parent, agent/teacher and the exhibitor must be mailed with the correct fees postmarked by November 16, 2023. Entry fees are \$25.00 per animal and \$5.00 for each species for showmanship. [\\$22.00 per t-shirt](#). *Late entry fee will be an additional \$20.00 per exhibitor.* Make checks payable to Fannin County Young Farmers.

4. Shavings are \$7.00 per stall to cover the cost of shavings. Please indicate the number needed by adding the \$7.00 per stall to your entry form fee amount. You may bring your own shavings, please indicate "0" on the shavings needed line. Make checks payable to Fannin County Young Farmers. 5. Ewes and Does must be tagged with the official state ear tag on and before November 16, 2023.
6. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspections is required with the individual identification and the following statement: FLOCK OF ORIGIN IS FREE FROM FOOT ROT, SCABIES, CONTAGIOUS ECTHYMA (SORE MOUTH), CUTANEOUS FUNGAL LESIONS, SCRAPIE, And/or ANY OTHER INFECTIOUS DISEASE. Any visible sick animal will be asked to leave the premises.
7. All must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear.
8. Showmanship is open to all exhibitors. Showmanship will be broken down by grade in school. Classes will be combined based on numbers in each grade.
9. Ewes and does will be shown by weight.
10. Showing off the trailer will not be allowed, all animals will be assigned a pen by show staff.
11. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless they have more than 1 per class. Any substitute must be cleared by show management. A current 4-H or FFA member entered in the show may show the second animal.

12. Each exhibitor must furnish their own feed, feed trough, water pail and be responsible for their animal while at the show.
13. The show nor the Fannin County School System will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit, but will give the best care and attention to prevent loss or damage to any exhibitor.
14. Does and ewes can arrive in on Friday from 4:00 pm till 8:00 pm or from 7:00 am -9:00 am Saturday. The barn will be locked and secured at 8:30pm Friday night.
15. Premiums will be based on entries.
16. Concessions will be available for both breakfast and lunch.

This will enable us to return/shred checks if something forces us to cancel our show.
