● **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The Georgia Junior Livestock Foundation is offering one \$1,500 scholarship in memory of Lee Harris Jr. and five \$1,000.00 scholarships to high school seniors who have been actively involved in the Georgia Junior livestock program. These scholarships will be awarded to senior students who are exhibiting at the GJLF Expo.

Purpose:

- To recognize hard-working, dedicated young people who are pursuing their education after high school graduation
- To assist students who embody the standards of excellence demonstrated through 4-H and FFA projects
- To encourage leadership development through livestock and other youth projects
- To foster an awareness of the importance of agriculture and to encourage an appreciation of the values and opportunities of rural life

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a high school senior
- Applicant must enter the 2024 GJLF Expo
- Applicant must be planning on attending a secondary school following graduation from high school including college, technical and trade schools.

Requirements:

- Applicants must submit a video of two minutes maximum length answering... *What do you consider to be the (1-3) greatest threats to the livestock industry, and how has your time in the junior livestock programs prepared you to help combat those?*
- Applicants must submit one letter of reference from teachers, advisors or cooperative extension agents. Please submit this with your application.
- Applicants should submit all required documents in PDF format.
- Top applicants must be present for an in-person interview at the GJLF Expo on December 13th.
- Winning Recipients must use the scholarship money for tuition, room and board, textbooks and supplies or other education-related expenses
- Winning Recipients must satisfactorily complete one quarter or semester with a minimum course load of 10 hours and a GPA of 2.0 or above to receive payment. Recipients must send a copy of their grades on official transcript from the school attended to receive payment
- Recipients must send a written thank you note to the Georgia Junior Livestock Foundation

- In the event the scholarship is not used within one year following graduation from high school, the recipient may request a time extension in the form of a letter explaining the delay in the use of the monies (example: military service, illness, financial limitations, etc.)
