Heifers will be sorted into classes by weight.

Showmanship (8) classes will be based on grade in school. Placings will be reported to the GJLF Point Circuit. All classes will be divided as equal as possible based on number of entries. Power is LIMITED, there is a small wash bay. Please be prepared to spot wash if necessary. Be advised to bring a generator if you have one. RV Hook-ups are available if needed (\$30). If you need to stay an additional day due to weather, it can be arranged.

Entry Fee is \$28.00 per animal. No limit per exhibitor. Late entries will be excepted with a \$10 late fee, No exceptions.
